Junior class students Pia Cardenas and Arianna Benoit will be presenting about their work in the theatre department, particularly around a recent project "Yo Vivo," and will be joined by the wonderful theatre team of Rachel Nadeau and ShaLayla Simmons. TAPA's work in the arts in distance learning is being seen as a model for better practices, and people are excited to hear from our students and staff!

It all boils down to this: the Great TAPA Distance Learning Effort will continue until it is safe for students to come back in person. Right now, with COVID levels higher than they have ever been, there is no way to increase in-person meetings and ensure our students', staff members' and families' safety. We'll continue to do what we can in-person (outdoor socially distanced conversations, pickups and meetups), and keep planning for a future when we can do more face-to-face. At the end of the day, we will rise from this challenge stronger if we all are able to care for our health and the health of our families.

As part of TAPA's effort to care for everyone in our Ensemble, we are collecting funds and food for Holiday Gifts and Food Baskets to be distributed in late December. If you or your family could use a food basket or gifts please let Ms.Vidal know. This is a particularly hard time in a particularly hard year, and no one should be ashamed of accepting help. As an Ensemble, we are only as strong as our weakest link: let us help and strengthen you if we can.

Additionally, in order to make the holidays a little more merry -- and thanks to the relentless advocacy of TAPA 7th grader Maryam Alaje -- we are lengthening our Winter Break to be two full weeks; it will begin on 12/21 and extend through until 1/1. In other big calendar news, we'll be doing Arts Auditions for the TAPA Class of 2024 (the current 9th grade) in

February, to make up for the auditions that were cancelled due to the pandemic last spring. While these auditions will be online, we are making tentative plans for some more lively springtime arts events, including a drive in movie set up by a TAPA Class of 2016 Alum.
