

TAPA MIDTERM EXPECTATIONS:

1: THERE ARE NO EXEMPTIONS FOR MIDTERM EXAMS. All TAPA students (grades 7-12) take midterms in every class.*

2: All TAPA teachers (grades 7-12) develop and administer a midterm in all of their classes.*

*The only exceptions are Seminar classes (grades 7-9), and the Seniors in “College Prep” and “Dual Enrollment,” as they will take college course exams.

For Final Exams ONLY, seniors who have received a High Honors grade every quarter (A- and above) receive an exemption from an academic exam.

3: The grade for the midterm is entered in a separate grade bucket on Skyward and counts for 10% of the student's final grade, as do Final Exams.

4: Students must be ON TIME (8:12am & 9:57am) for exams. There will be no admittance after the start of exam time, which is at **8:12am** for Exam 1 and **9:57am** for Exam 2.

- Makeup Exams must be scheduled by an email or in person with the teacher at a mutually agreeable date and time prior to Friday, January 25th at 4pm.
- Available slots for Makeup Exams include after 12pm on January 23-24th, and after 9:57am on January 25th. 9th and 12th graders also have additional slots on January 25th.
- Makeup Exams will receive a 1-letter-grade deduction unless the absence was excused.
 - Students with *extenuating circumstances* may makeup exams on an alternate schedule at the discretion of the Guidance Counselor and teacher.
