## Behavioral Expectations for TAPA Prom

Prom is a TAPA school event. Any student who violates the behavioral expectations at Prom will lose their privilege to participate, and a parent will be called for pickup. Depending on the severity of the violation, the student may also lose the privilege to attend future TAPA events (including their senior prom, if in 9th-11th grade, or their graduation ceremony). TAPA students are held equally responsible for the behavior of their guest, and thus will lose future event participation privileges if guests violate our rules.

## **Not Permitted:**

1. Alcohol or drugs. Any student who comes to Prom under the influence of or in possession of alcohol or drugs will be immediately dismissed from the event and require a pick-up from a parent or other contact. Attendees will lose the privilege to attend future TAPA events.
2. Large bags (handbags, backpacks) may not be brought past check-in. There will be an area to securely check bags and other items.
3. Leaving the premise (Southside Cultural Center) and returning. There will be no re-admittance.
4. Entry at the door without having submitted a participation form and ticket payment in advance.
5. Remaining on the premise of Southside Cultural Center after the event has ended (past 10:15pm)
6. Any behavior deemed unsafe by the administration and chaperones on sight at Prom (i.e. threatening or disruptive behavior).

## Attendance Expectations for Participation in Prom

For TAPA students, regular school attendance is expected to earn the privilege to attend Prom. Students with chronic tardiness or absences (who do not have an extenuating circumstance that has been confirmed by the Guidance Counselor and Dean of Students) may lose the privilege to participate.
